Flipster allows you to access the latest issues of popular magazines in full color. This resource is available on a desktop computer or a mobile device.

How to Access Flipster on Your Computer

- 1. Go to the library website, <u>lincolnwoodlibrary.org</u>
- 2. Hover on **Resources** and select All **Resources**.
- 3. Select View Resource under Flipster.
- 4. If you are in the Library, you will be automatically logged in. If you are outside the library, enter your **21242000XXXXXX** library card number in the **Library Card** field.
- 5. Click Sign In.

How to Access Flipster on Your Mobile Device

- Download and install the free Flipster app available for Android, Apple, and Kindle Fire.

 Get Started
- Tap the blue Get Started button.
- Type Lincolnwood in the Find My Library search field at the top of the screen, tap Log In.



- On the log in screen, tap Library Card. There is no User ID/Password.
- Enter your library card number and press log in.


Find magazines on your computer

There are several ways to access the magazine you're looking for.

You may search for magazines by **categories**, **latest issues**, or the search box at the top of the page.




Once you've found the magazine you want to read, click on its cover and a page will open where you can learn more about the magazine. To read the latest issue, click **Read now**. If you want to read a past issue, click on a cover under **All issues**.

Downloading titles on your mobile device


To access the magazine you're looking for, scroll through the main **Explore** section, search by category by tapping the **Categories** button at the top left, or the **Q** icon at the top right to search for a specific title.

When you've found the magazine you want to read, tap the cover of the magazine. You will then be able to download the most recent or past issue of this magazine. To download the latest issue, click the blue **Download** button. You will see past issues of this magazine directly below. Tap on any previous issue, if that's the one you're looking for.

Tap the green **Read** button which appears.



Once a magazine has been downloaded, it is available for offline reading. All downloaded magazines are accessible in the **My Shelf** tab found at the bottom of the screen.



To remove a title, tap the imicon under the title.

Magazines in the collection are always available with no wait. But checkout length varies depending on the magazine.

Reading an issue on your mobile device

Go to My Shelf and tap on a magazine cover. Then:


- To flip through the magazine, swipe your finger right or left across the screen.
- To view the table of contents, with links to each article, tap the icon in the upper right-hand corner.
- Zoom in and out on pictures, text, and other content with standard system gestures like pinching two fingers in and out.

Text view and spoken text

Tap **Text View** in the upper right hand corner of an article to read a text only version of the article with images and ads removed. (Text View only appears on articles, not on full-page advertisements.)



Within Text View, select the speaker to have the page read out loud.



Tap **Cancel** or **Page View** to return to the magazine page view.

Bookmark a page

Once you've found an article you want to bookmark, tap the **bookmark** in the upper left corner.



Type a bookmark name in the field provided and tap **Save.** To access your bookmarks, tap the **Bookmarks** link in the upper left corner of the **My Shelf** page.
