- Check out up to **five** eBooks or eAudiobooks at a time for 7, 14 or 21 days
- Items return automatically
- Renewals available for items with no holds
- This service is for Lincolnwood Library resident cardholders only (check with your home library for OverDrive access)

Tip: The default checkout period is 14 days for eBooks and eAudiobooks. To change the lending period, go to **My Media Mall > the ☰ icon in the upper right corner > My account > Settings > Lending Periods** and change your preferences for each format.



Returning Downloaded Items Early

Though items automatically expire at the end of the lending period, you can return downloaded items early from the **OverDrive App Bookshelf**.

1. Launch the **OverDrive App** and sign in
2. Tap **Bookshelf**
3. Tap the book's cover and then tap **Return to library**
4. To return multiple items at once, tap **Edit** in the top right corner

Getting Started

Step 1 Download the free OverDrive app from the Apple App Store, Google Play, or your device's app center. *Note: If you have an older Nook Tablet or Nook Color, please see the guide for Nook Devices.*



Step 2 Open the app and follow the prompts to create an OverDrive account, then sign in.

Step 3 In the OverDrive app, tap on the ☰ icon in the upper left corner. Then, tap **Add a library** and search for Lincolnwood.

- Tap **Lincolnwood Public Library**
- Tap **My Media Mall** and start browsing

Browse, Borrow, & Download

Step 1 Launch the OverDrive app and tap **My Media Mall**.

Step 2 In the upper middle part of the screen, tap **Sign In**. Follow the prompts to choose your library and enter your library card number (no spaces).


Step 3 To browse genres, manage your account, or search for titles, tap the ☰ icon on the right side of the screen next to the 📱 icon. From here, you can access the following:

Search: Enter specific titles or use Advanced Search


My account: Manage checkouts, holds and preferences

Help: Get Help from Overdrive

Tip: To see which eBooks and eAudiobooks are available now, tap on **Collections**. To see all available titles under a specific format, tap **Available Now**. You can sort results by **Title, Author, Popularity, or Date Added**.




Step 4 When you find a book you like, tap **Borrow**. If the title is already checked out, you can also tap **Place a Hold** and receive notification when it becomes available.



Step 5 If you borrow a title from its details page, you'll see a button suggesting the best way to enjoy the title on your current device:



Tap **Add to app** to add an eBook or eAudiobook to your bookshelf in the OverDrive app. For eBooks, tap **Choose a format**, then select **EPUB eBook** to add it to the OverDrive app.



Step 6 To read or listen to your downloaded book(s), tap on the ☰ icon in the upper left corner, and tap Bookshelf. Then, tap the cover of the book to get started.
