

What is Creativebug?

Creativebug is your go-to resource for high-quality arts and crafts instructional videos. With your library card, you get ondemand access to a library of more than 1,000 arts and crafts classes for artists and makers of all levels. You'll enjoy award-winning HD instructional videos on drawing, painting, sewing, knitting, crochet, quilting, baking and more. All classes are taught by experts, with new classes added frequently.


How to access Creativebug

This resource is available *both* inside the library and at home to **Lincolnwood cardholders only.**

- 1. Go to the library's website, <u>lincolnwoodlibrary.org</u>
- 2. Hover over **Resources** and select **All Resources**.
- 3. Under Creativebug, select View Resource.
- 4. Type in your Lincolnwood Library card number in the field provided, and click **Log In.**



5. If this is your first time using Creativebug, you will be asked to provide your name and e-mail address to create an account. Then click **Submit**.



6. Select **Browse All Classes** to access everything Creativebug has to offer.

Daily Practice: Challenge yourself to a month of making! These 30-day prompts are the perfect way to launch your daily art practice. With over 60 to choose from, that's 5+ years of daily creativity.

Resources: View a **Calendar** of upcoming releases, get to know the **Instructors**, read their **Blog**, explore **CBTV** for more in-depth videos, browse the **Pattern Library** for downloadable PDFs, or search **Class Collections** for related videos.

Find a class


To find a specific class, click on the **Classes** menu at the top of the page. There are several ways on finding a class.

The first way is to browse all the available categories. If you hover the mouse over the **Classes** menu, 10 categories will appear. Hover the mouse over that category to see the different subcategories.




For more detailed instruction, book a one-on-one session with a librarian. Registration requires a Lincolnwood Library Card. For scheduling, contact Adult Services at (224) 233-1859.

The second way is by using the filters. Click on **Classes**, then on **Filter results** on the right hand side.



Select the category, the class type, or instructor and press the red **Apply** button that will appear. You will be able to sort the results by release date, popularity, or top rated.

The third way is to simply **search** what you're looking for by typing it in the search box. For example if you search for *drawing*, you will see suggestions to choose from.


Viewing a class

When you've found a class you're interested in, click on the class to view more information.


For every class you will have the option to view the **description** of the class, navigate through the various **chapters**, get a list of **materials** you may need, see a **gallery** of other members' projects from the class, write **notes**, add the video to your **watchlist**, and read a **transcript**. Some videos have the option to **download** a PDF with instructions.



To start watching the class, click the **play** button in the middle of the screen.



If you're viewing a multi-part class, you can advance to the subsequent parts by clicking the **Play** button.



Download crochet & knitting patterns

Creativebug offers a large library of crochet and kitting patterns which are easy to download.

Under the **Resources** menu, select **Pattern Library**.



This collection is full of stitching inspiration, with new downloadable patterns added every season. To download a PDF, simply click the red **Download** button.



Big Tartan Crochet Super Scarf

Nothing like a huge tartan scarf to brighten up those dreary winter days! Crocheted in Patons Shetland Chunky and Shetland Chunky Tweeds, the punch of orange will stand out in the sea of winter coats.

Skill level: Intermediate

Yarn: PATONS Shetland Chunky, 5 skeins in Gold (A); 5 skeins in Aran (B): PATONS Shetland Chunky


Tweeds, 3 skeins Charcoal Tweeds (C); 2 skeins Pewter Tweeds (D) Crochet Hook: US L/10.5 (6.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge: 12 sc and 11 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern
