What is Driving-tests.org?

Driving-tests.org is a simple but useful resource that provides access to a variety of free practice tests covering standard cars to motorcycles, and CDL. It provides access to the full updated Rules of the Road handbook, information on Vehicle Identification Numbers (VINs), and more. We subscribe to basic version, **Premium** resources may be restricted.

How can you access Driving-tests.org?

No login is required beyond clicking through from the library website as described below. This authenticates and logs you in. If you accidentally get logged out, follow these steps again.

1. Go to the library's website, lincolnwoodlibrary.org
2. Hover over **Resources**. Select **Quick Links**.
3. Select **Driver's License Practice Tests**.

Browsing courses and starting a test

Tabs for **Car Tests**, **CDL Tests**, and **Motorcycle Tests** make the multiple tests for each type of certification easy to find. Single click to switch test types. Scroll through the tests.

- Each group of tests are split by categories like **Easy, Hard, Hardest, School Bus, Tanker Vehicles**, and more.
- To start a test, click on its title, such as Practice Test 1.



Taking a practice test

Tests have no time limit, and courses list how many questions you can get wrong and still pass.

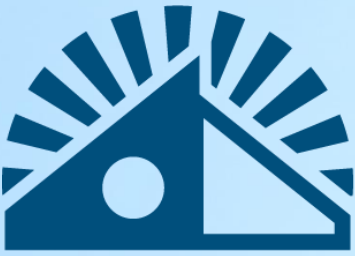
- To answer questions, single click the **circle** next to a choice.
- Select **Next Question** to go to the next question.
- **Your Progress** is monitored to the left, including how many questions you have answered correctly/incorrectly.
- **Green** = correct answer
- **Red** = incorrect answer
- **Light blue outline** = question you are looking at but haven't answered yet.

- **Hint** = Select this to get a hint to help you with any question.
- **View Handbook** = Select this to go to the handbook that applies to the test you're currently taking.
- **< All Tests** = Select this to exit a test and see others. Your progress is remembered and you can resume from where you were by selecting the same test from the **Car Tests**, **CDL Tests**, or **Motorcycle Tests** tabs of the homepage.

- Select Help and then Click **FAQ** (Frequently Asked Questions) or scroll down to the bottom of the Driving-tests.org homepage to see answers to many questions.
- In the tabs for **Car Tests**, **CDL Tests**, and **Motorcycle Tests** there is a section for The Handbook which allows you to read it online or download for printing.
 - You can also have handbooks read to you provided you have speakers or headphones and sound turned on.
- Scroll all the way down to the bottom and click **Bill of Sale** for a free downloadable and printable contract template.
- Also at the bottom, click **VIN Decoder** for information on what the codes of Vehicle Identifications Numbers mean.
