How to access LOTE 4Kids

- 1. From the library's website www.lincolnwoodlibrary.org, select the **Resources** tab from the top menu.
- Then click on Resource Quick.
- 3. Click on the Lote4Kids.
- 4. Enter your Lincolnwood library card number into the login page.

Searching the LOTE 4Kids Database



To get started searching for books in LOTE 4Kids:

- Click on the flag button above the desired language.
- Browse through available titles, or sort according to:
 - Latest Release
 - Most popular
 - A to Z
 - Z to A
- You can also search for a title using the search box near the top of the page.
- To view all available sign language books, click on the Sign tab at the top menu.
- Clicking on the Books tab at the top menu will bring you back to the home page.



Reading LOTE 4Kids Books





Once you have located a book that interests you, select the yellow button for the format in which you would like to read:

- The selected language (Urdu, Swedish, Polish, etc.)
- English
- Bilingual
- Flipbook

To get started, you select play and the book is read aloud to you in the language chosen.

- In the English and Selected language versions, a narrator reads the text aloud and the words are highlighted so you can follow along.
- In Flipbook, you flip through the pages and read to yourself, or you can select the movie icon and a narrator will read aloud but there will be no highlighted text and the video looks more like the pages of a book turning.
- Whichever version you select allows you quick access to the other versions on the right hand side of the page.
 Underneath the other versions are a list of similar books.
- Selected books offer guiz guestions about the books.

LOTE 4Kids Mobile App

You can also access LOTE 4Kids through the mobile app, which is available through the Google Play store for Android and the App Store for Apple devices.

After downloading the app, you search for Lincolnwood Library and enter your library card number to access the same great content from your device!




LOTE 4Kids Additional Features
