What is Tutor.com?



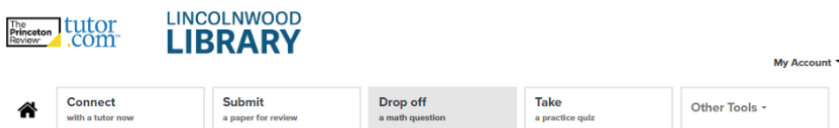

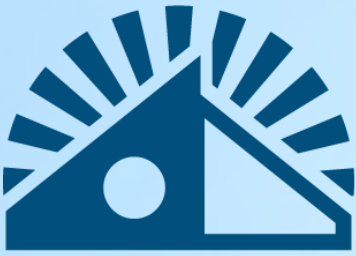
